U.S. citizens or permanent residents age 62 and over can purchase a lifetime pass for \$10.00 in person at the park, or \$20.00 by mail. The pass provides access to, and use of, Federal recreation sites that charge an entrance fee. The pass admits the pass holder and passengers in a non-commercial vehicle at “per vehicle” fee areas (children under 16 are admitted free). At many parks, the Senior Pass provides a 50 percent discount on amenities such as camping, swimming, boat launch, and specialized interpretive services.
