

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE 2018 ACTION PLAN – SUBSTANTIAL  
AMENDMENT #1 FOR THE DU PAGE COUNTY CONSORTIUM

DuPage County is beginning preparation of the 2018 Action Plan describing the use of these funds for the next program year. A public hearing to obtain input for the Action Plan – Substantial Amendment #1 will be held as follows:

DuPage County will receive approximately \$3.95 million in funding from the Community Development Block Grant Program, \$290,000 from the Emergency Solutions Grant Program, and \$1.82 million from the HOME Investment Partnerships Act Program for a total of approximately \$6 million in Federal funding for FY2018. The overall goal of these three programs is to develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities principally for low and moderate income persons. The DuPage County Consortium covers a majority of DuPage County and portions of Naperville that are inside of DuPage County and excludes the City of Aurora. It is estimated that 100% of DuPage County funds received from these three programs, and covered by the Consolidated Plan, will benefit persons of low and moderate income.
