ORDER

This matter coming before the Court, due notice having been given, the parties being present through counsel and the Trustee-In-Dissolution being personally present, and the Court having jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter and being duly advised in the premises:

The Court hereby finds as follows:

The HIGHLAND HILLS SANITARY DISTRICT (hereinafter referred to as the "DISTRICT") is an Illinois Sanitary District existing and organized pursuant to 70 ILCS 2405/1, et seq.; and

The DISTRICT, in accordance with The Local Government Reduction and Efficiency Act (55 ILCS 5/5-44005, et seq.), (the "Act"), the DuPage County Board and Highland Hills Sanitary District have done each and every act necessary to dissolve the District as a governmental unit and to consolidate or transfer the DISTRICT'S functions to other public bodies; and

The DISTRICT has disposed of its public records in the manner proscribed by law; and

The DISTRICT has disposed of all its real and personal property, excepting for cash receivables described below, and, thus, no longer owns or possesses any property other than said due and owing cash sums; and

The DISTRICT has concluded its contractual obligations, including final payment to Trustee-In-Dissolution Ronald D. Menna, Jr., of Fischel & Kahn, Ltd., but excepting the receipt of certain cash receivables and making a final and full payment to the County of DuPage for services rendered; and

The DISTRICT has authorized payment of an amount owed to the County of DuPage ("County") in the sum \$27,658.68 but has no funds to pay said amount; and

The DISTRICT does have cash receivables due and owed in the sum of, approximately, \$4,500.00, which amount is an approximate sum of an insurance refund by Hartford Insurance (\$4,400.00) and the disbursement of a nominal amount from the Illinois State Treasurer; and

The DISTRICT and County have agreed to compromise, settle, and payoff the County's invoice in an amount equal to the District's cash receivables due, owed and collected by the DuPage County Treasurer, provided that such receivables do not exceed the amount of \$27,658.68; and

The DISTRICT assigned and transferred such cash receivables due and owed, to the County up to the sum of \$27,658.68; and

The District, by resolution dated July 10, 2019, has ceased and terminated all further operations.

Based on the foregoing, it is hereby Ordered as followed:

1. The appointment of Ronald D. Menna, Jr., as the Trustee-In-Dissolution is hereby terminated effective immediately.
2. The Highland Hills Sanitary District is hereby dissolved effective immediately.
3. The DuPage County Treasurer, also serving as the DISTRICT'S *ex officio* Treasurer, is directed to collect such cash receivables due and owed the DISTRICT and to turnover such sums, upon collection, to the County of DuPage up to but not exceeding the amount of \$27,658.68. The amount owed by the DISTRICT to the County shall be deemed compromised and satisfied upon turnover of receivables hereafter collected by the Treasurer.
4. The Petitioner, Daniel Cronin, as DuPage County Board Chairman, is directed to transmit certified copies of this Order to the Illinois State Treasurer and the Illinois Local Records Commission, and to further post a copy of this order on the County of DuPage's website.
5. This case is closed.
