Dear Liquor License Holder:

Over the last several days, I have received correspondence expressing concerns regarding the operation of your business during these unprecedented economic times that are not only impacting our health but also our economy.

As such, by the authority vested in me as DuPage County Liquor Control Commissioner, I am allowing Class B Liquor License holders who currently possess a valid Food Service permit from the DuPage County Health Department, to sell alcoholic liquor off-premises for delivery or curbside pick-up, so long as it is accompanied with a minimum food order of \$10. This Rule shall take effect on March 31, 2020 and terminate (subject to further review) on May 12, 2020.

Enclosed please find a copy of the revised Rule. I hope this change will assist with the operation of your business at this time. Please feel free to contact my office should you require additional information.
