This order is entered pursuant to authority contained in Supreme Court Rules 21(b) and 295, and supersedes Administrative Order 14-1 and all amendments thereto, and provides for the following:

**SECTION I - DIVISIONS OF THE COURT AND PRESIDING JUDGES**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective December 1, 2014 six divisions of the Court are established and the Presiding Judges of the various divisions are as follows:

**SECTION II - ASSIGNMENTS OF CASES TO DIVISIONS**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, except as otherwise provided herein, types of cases normally assigned to and heard within each of the six divisions of this Court shall be and are as follows:

The Felony Division of the Court shall routinely hear all facets of the following types of cases:

- Miscellaneous Remedy (MR) } Eavesdropping, Habeas Corpus,  
} Extradition and Fugitive from Justice only
- Grand Jury Matters

## B. MISDEMEANOR/TRAFFIC DIVISION

The Misdemeanor/Traffic Division of the Court shall routinely hear all facets of the following types of cases:

- Criminal Misdemeanor (CM) } Classes A and B
- DT Cases (TR and OV)
  - Traffic (TR) } Companion to CM or DT cases except
  - Ordinance Violation (OV) } where also companion to CF cases
  - Domestic Violence (DV)
  - Miscellaneous Remedy (MR) } Eavesdropping only
- Orders of Protection (OP)

### Traffic:

- Criminal Misdemeanor (CM) } Class C and Petty Offense only
- Traffic (TR) } Except where companion to CF, CM
- Ordinance Violation (OV) } [Classes A & B] and DUI
- Conservation Violation (CV)
- Township Violation (TV)

## C. LAW DIVISION

The Law Division of the Court shall routinely hear all facets of the following types of cases:

- Law (L)
- Arbitration (AR)
- Eminent Domain (ED)
- Small Claims (SC) (SR)
- Law Magistrate (LM) (FED)

#### **D. CHANCERY DIVISION**

The Chancery Division of the Court shall routinely hear all facets of the following types of cases:

- Adoption (AD)
- Chancery (CH)
- Law Magistrate (LM)
- Mental Health (MH)
- Miscellaneous Remedy (MR)- except for registration of foreign divorce judgments, eavesdropping, extradition, fugitive from justice, habeas corpus and juvenile reimbursements
- Municipal Corporations (MC)
- Probate (P)
- Tax (TX)
- LM/FED Over \$50,000
- Contempt of Court (CC) } Unauthorized Practice of Law Only

#### **E. DOMESTIC RELATIONS/JUVENILE DIVISION**

The Domestic Relations Division of the Court shall routinely hear all facets of the following types of cases:

- Divorce (D)
- Family (F)
- Juvenile (J) (JA) (JD)
- Miscellaneous Remedy (MR) - Registration of foreign divorce judgments, foreign support orders and juvenile reimbursements

#### **F. CHIEF JUDGE'S DIVISION**

##### Duty Division

Associate Judges may be assigned by the Chief Judge to the Duty Division, including 4:00 p.m. Bond Court, Bond Court on Saturday, Sunday and holidays; and on call after court hours, including matters under Section IV F.

##### Marriage Division

Associate Judges may be assigned by the Chief Judge to Marriage Division. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 40, the Marriage Division will conduct civil marriage ceremonies in the DuPage County Judicial Center, 505 N. County Farm Road, Wheaton, Illinois, on dates and times to be established by order of the Chief Judge.

##### Support Division

One or more Circuit or Associate Judges may be assigned to the Support Division, to provide back-up for traffic court, summary suspension hearings and emergency orders of protection, for vacations and other absences.

**SECTION III - ASSIGNMENT OF JUDGES TO COURTROOMS**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to the following, judges, courtrooms and hearing times be and are hereby assigned within each division of the Court. Filings shall only be scheduled by the Clerk on days and times as set forth in this Section. Filings and notices that do not comport with this requirement, may be refused by the Circuit Clerk, or at the Clerk's option, may be given an appropriate subsequent date and time, in which case the Clerk shall give notice of the date and time to the filing party.

## **SECTION IV - CASE ASSIGNMENTS AND REASSIGNMENTS WITHIN DIVISIONS**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all initial case assignments and subsequent reassignments within and between divisions shall be as follows:

### **A. FELONY DIVISION**

#### **Initial Assignments**

All cases with a designation of CF, including Felony DUI, and MR (Eavesdropping, Extradition, Fugitive from Justice and Habeas Corpus only) shall, upon filing of an indictment, information or complaint, be randomly assigned and distributed among the judges in the Felony Division as follows: Courtrooms 4000, 4004, 4006, 4010 and 4012 – 16.7% and Courtroom 4014 – 16.5%.

All companion CM, DV, DT, TR or OV cases shall follow the CF.

1. All cases filed against a given defendant at the same time, regardless of case category, shall be assigned by the Clerk of the Court to the same courtroom. It shall be the responsibility of the judge(s) to identify companion cases and to transfer them into one courtroom.
2. All cases with a designation of MR (eavesdropping only) are to be assigned to Circuit Judges and Associate Judges designated by administrative order.

#### **Reassignments**

3. All pending cases requiring reassignment within the Felony Division shall be transferred to the Presiding Judge of that division who shall reassign the case by use of Form 2194 (Rev 3/97).
4. The Presiding Judge shall reassign within the division. All cases designated “closed” or “inactive” which reappear on a court call will remain on the court’s call where it was originally assigned.

### **B. MISDEMEANOR/TRAFFIC DIVISION**

#### **MISDEMEANOR –** **Initial Assignments**

1. Unless companion to a CF case, those cases from Elmhurst, Naperville, Villa Park, Lemont, Bloomingdale, METRA, Forest Preserve, ICC, Geneva, Glendale Heights, Hinsdale, Illinois Conservation Police, Illinois State Police District 2, Wayne and Schaumburg with a designation of DT (DUI only), along with any companion CM, TR or OV cases, shall upon filing be assigned to Courtroom 4002.

Unless companion to a CF case, those cases from Addison, Glen Ellyn, Burr Ridge, Itasca, Hanover Park, Carol Stream, Illinois State Police Districts 3, 4 and 5, Lisle, Bartlett, Oakbrook Terrace, Animal Control, Woodridge, BNSF RR, Sheriff’s Office, Wheaton, UPRR, SOS, St. Charles, Winfield and Roselle with a designation of DT (DUI only), along with any companion CM, TR or OV cases, shall upon filing be assigned to Courtroom 4015.

Unless companion to a CF case, those cases from Westmont, Clarendon Hills, Willowbrook, Warrenville, Bensenville, Wood Dale, West Chicago, COD, Elk Grove, Aurora, Darien, Bolingbrook, Illinois Benedictine, Downers Grove, Illinois State Police District 15, Lombard, Chicago O'Hare and Oakbrook with a designation of DT (DUI only), along with any companion CM, TR or OV cases, shall upon filing be assigned to Courtroom 4017.

2. Unless companion to a CF case, all Class A and B misdemeanor cases and all CM cases filed via information, and all cases companion thereto, shall upon filing be assigned to the judges who regularly hear CM cases as follows: Courtrooms 4003, 4005 and 4007-27%; 4001-19%.
3. All cases with a designation of DV shall be assigned to Courtroom 2004 and 2006 - 50%.
4. All cases with designations of CM, TR and OV which have been transferred from a Traffic Division court for jury trial or appointment of public defender shall be assigned according to Circuit Court Rules 35.02 and 35.05; and all Class C Misdemeanor possession of not more than 2.5 grams of cannabis or attempt to possess not more than 2.5 grams of cannabis cases that request either a bench trial or jury trial in field court will be assigned as follows:

Addison Field Court to Courtroom 4005  
Downers Grove Field Court to Courtroom 4003  
Glendale Heights Field Court to Courtroom 2006  
Wheaton Field Court to Courtroom 4007

5. Cases with a designation of OP shall be assigned to a judge and courtroom in accordance with the schedule appearing in Section III B hereof. Petitions for Emergency Orders of Protection in all case types (regardless of case assignment) will be heard in accordance with the schedule appearing in Section III B.

#### Reassignments

6. Pending cases requiring reassignment within the Misdemeanor Division shall be transferred to the Presiding Judge of that division, who shall reassign the case by use of Form 2194 (Rev. 3/97). All such cases shall be assigned equally among the judges assigned to the Misdemeanor Division.
7. The Presiding Judge shall reassign, within the division, all cases designated "closed" or "inactive" which reappear on a court call of any judge formerly but not presently assigned to this division.

#### TRAFFIC -

##### Initial Assignments

1. All Ordinance Violation (OV), Conservation Violation (CV) cases and Traffic (TR) cases, including DWLS, Reckless Driving, Fleeing a Police Officer, Unlawful Display of Registration, and any other Class A and B misdemeanor with a TR designation or a CV designation except DT cases or CF cases, shall be placed on the dockets of the judges presiding in the following field courts: Addison, Downers Grove, Glendale Heights and Wheaton. All Township Violation (TV) cases shall be placed on the docket of the judge presiding in the Wheaton Field Court.

2. Except companion to CF, DT or OV, and except for all CM cases filed via information, all CM, Class C and Petty Offense misdemeanors shall be assigned and distributed among the Traffic Division judges according to a master traffic court schedule.

### **C. LAW DIVISION**

#### Initial Assignments

1. All cases with a designation of L or ED upon filing shall be randomly assigned and distributed among the five judges who regularly hear L and ED cases as identified in Section III C hereof according to the following formula: Courtrooms 2008 - 20%, 2010 - 20%, 2014 - 20%, 2016 - 20% and 2020 - 20%.
2. All cases with a designation of AR shall be assigned as identified in Section III C hereof.
3. All cases with a designation of SC and SR upon filing shall be assigned as identified in Section III C hereof.
4. Cases with a designation of LM shall be assigned as follows: Except for non-residential forcibles, all other Forcible Entry & Detainer, Ejectment and Distress for Rent cases and residential mortgage foreclosure cases shall be assigned to Courtroom 2000 and 2018 - 50%.

#### Reassignments

5. All cases, except SC, SR and AR cases, requiring reassignment within the Law Division shall be transferred to the Presiding Judge of the Law Division who shall reassign the case by use of Form 2194 (Rev 3/97).
6. All cases designated SC, SR and AR may be transferred directly to any judge assigned to handle either SC and AR cases in those situations where the assigned judge recuses him/herself or where a substitution of judge is sought other than based on actual prejudice. All other cases shall be reassigned to the Presiding Judge using Form 2194 (Rev 3/97).
7. The Presiding Judge shall reassign, within the division, all cases designated "closed" or "inactive" which reappear on a court call of any judge formerly but not presently assigned to this division.

### **D. CHANCERY DIVISION**

#### Initial Assignments

1. All cases with a designation of CH (except mortgage foreclosures) and MR (except foreign divorce judgments, eavesdropping and habeas corpus) upon filing shall be randomly assigned and distributed among the two judges who regularly hear CH and MR cases as identified in Section III D hereof as follows: Courtrooms 2005 and 2007 - 50%. All CH mortgage foreclosures shall be assigned as identified in Section III D hereof. All MR vehicle forfeiture and asset forfeiture cases shall be assigned as identified in Section III hereof.

2. All cases with a designation of AD, MH, MC, P, TX, TD, TO, MR, Asset Forfeiture and MM shall be assigned as identified in Section III D hereof.
3. All cases with a designation of CH which are non-residential mortgage foreclosures shall be assigned to Courtroom 2007.
4. Cases with the designation of LM/Forcible Entry and Detainer which are not-residential, over \$50,000, shall be assigned to Courtroom 2007.
5. All CC cases filed pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Rule 779(b) will be assigned to Courtroom 2005 – 50% and Courtroom 2007 – 50%.

Reassignments

6. All pending cases requiring reassignment within the Chancery Division shall be transferred to the Presiding Judge of that division who shall reassign the case by use of Form 2194 (Rev 3/97).
7. The Presiding Judge shall reassign, within the division, all cases designated “closed” or “inactive” which reappear on a court call of any judge formerly but not presently assigned to this division.

**E. DOMESTIC RELATIONS/JUVENILE**

Initial Assignments

1. All cases with a designation of D or MR (Registration of Foreign Divorce proceedings only) shall be randomly assigned and distributed equally among the judges assigned to the Domestic Relations Division Courtrooms 3002, 3003, 3004, 3005, 3006, 3007 and 3009 as identified in Section III E hereof.
2. All cases with a designation of F (except Parental Notification of Abortion) shall be assigned to Courtroom 4016 if they are filed by the State’s Attorney. If they are filed by a private attorney or Pro-Se, they shall be assigned to Courtroom 2011.

All cases with a designation of MR (Juvenile Reimbursements) and F (Parental Notification of Abortion) shall be assigned to the judge and courtroom in accordance with the schedule appearing in Section III E hereof.

3. All cases with a designation of J, JA and JD shall be assigned to a judge and courtroom in accordance with the schedule appearing in Section III E hereof.

Reassignments

4. All pending cases requiring reassignment within the Domestic Relations Division shall be transferred to the Presiding Judge of that division who shall reassign the case by use of Form 2194 (Rev 3/97).
5. The Presiding Judge shall reassign, within the division, all cases designated “closed” or “inactive” which reappear on a court call of any judge formerly but not necessary assigned to this division.

Petitions for Waiver of Parental Notice Pursuant to 750 ILC 70/25

6. Petitions for waiver of notice will be heard in the Domestic Relations Division, Juvenile. Immediately upon filing, the Circuit Court Clerk will walk the file up to the assigned judge. Proceedings on the Petition shall take precedence over any other matters pending before the Court to the extent necessary to ensure that the Court promptly reaches a decision on the Petition.

Any Petition filed after 3:00 p.m. will be set before the assigned judge at 8:30 a.m. on the next business day.

7. If the assigned Juvenile Judge is not available, the matter will be immediately delivered to the other Juvenile Judge. If neither Juvenile Judge is available, the matter will be immediately delivered to the Presiding Judge of Domestic Relations, who will assign the matter.

Petition for Appellate Review of Denial of Waiver

8. Upon denial by the trial court, the court reporter shall be ordered to prepare a transcript of all the proceedings, which transcript shall be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court within twenty-four hours of the entry of the order.
9. Upon denial by the trial court, Petitioner shall be provided with the "Petition for Review of the Denial of a Waiver of Notice" form to be filed with the Circuit Court Clerk's Office.
10. In cases where a Petition for Appellate Review has been filed, the Clerk of the Circuit Court shall, upon receipt of the transcript and preparation of record, contact the Clerk of the Appellate Court to arrange the prompt delivery of the record to the Appellate Court Clerk.

**F. CHIEF JUDGE'S DIVISION**

Duty Division

The Duty Division judges shall be assigned by the Chief Judge, on a rotating basis, to fulfill the obligations of the 18<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit during non-business hours, including bond court, search warrants, criminal complaints, emergency orders of protection, eavesdrop and other emergency matters as they arise. If the assigned Duty Division judge is unable to cover his or her duty assignment, it is that judge's responsibility to find a replacement and to notify the Chief Judge's Office of the change.

Marriage Division

The Marriage Division judges shall be assigned by the Chief Judge, on a rotating basis, to fulfill the obligations under Supreme Court Rule 40. If any assigned marriage judge is unable to cover his or her marriage assignment, it is that judge's responsibility to find a replacement and to notify the Chief Judge's Office of the change.

Support Division

Upon a written request for support and coverage by a Presiding Judge, the Chief Judge will assign the Support Division judge to fulfill the obligation of the absent judge.

**SECTION V - AUTHORITY OF PRESIDING JUDGES**

- A. Each Presiding Judge of a division shall have complete administrative authority and responsibility for the division, except for providing for divisions of court, the assignment of judges to divisions, the assignment of non-judicial personnel to divisions and within divisions, the times and places of holding court and the initial assignment of cases to individual judges, all of which are provided for herein.
  
- B. Grand Jury Assignments - The Presiding Judge of the Felony Division shall hear the requisition and impaneling of Grand Juries. Grand Jury proceedings under 725 ILCS 5/106-1 et seq. and 725 ILCS 5/112-1 et seq., shall be assigned by the Presiding Judge of the Felony Division to other judges within the Felony and Misdemeanor Divisions.

**SECTION VI - SPECIAL AND MISCELLANEOUS ASSIGNMENTS**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following miscellaneous assignments be and are hereby made:

- A. Out-of-County and Temporary Assignments  
Assignments shall be made by the Chief Judge.
  
- B. Chief Judge Assignments

The Chief Judge or his designate shall hear the following matters:


1. Assignment to a Presiding Judge subsequent to a change of venue; substitution or recusal of a judge when fairness requires assignment to a different division; and reassignment to a different division based upon the issues to be resolved.
2. Requisition and impaneling of petit juries.
3. Assignment of Presiding Judges to divisions.
4. Assignment of non-judicial personnel to divisions.
5. MR - Petitions for appointment of a state's attorney or special state's attorney.
6. MR - Petitions for Appointment of a Receiver under Supreme Court Rule 776.

- C. Acting Chief Judge Assignments

In the absence of the Chief Judge, the matters assigned to the Chief Judge in this Section VI shall be presented to the Acting Chief Judge. In the absence of the Acting Chief Judge, all matters will be assigned to the most senior Circuit Judge – Judge Bonnie M. Wheaton.

This Order shall become effective December 1, 2014 and remain in effect until further order of the Court. Administrative Order No. 14-1 and all amendments thereto be and are hereby vacated.
