WHEREAS, the 18th Judicial Circuit's Department of Probation and Court Services has been chosen as one of over 2400 jurisdictions in the Nation to provide juvenile court data to the National Center for Juvenile Justice (NCJJ). From these data, national estimates are produced which detail delinquency and status offense case handling; and

WHEREAS, DuPage County has been selected to increase the data coverage for the State of Illinois to improve the national estimates of juvenile court activity; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Probation and Court Services of the 18th Judicial Circuit has successfully worked with the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP), procuring grants to currently administer programs; and

WHEREAS, the OJJDP has granted funding to NCJJ to take over reporting on the Nation's juvenile court activity; and

WHEREAS, all data will be collected without personally identifying information; and


WHEREAS, the data that is provided by the Department of Probation and Court Services of the 18th Judicial Circuit will be aggregated with data from other jurisdictions included in the National Archive; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Probation and Probation Officers Act (730 ILCS 110/12(4)) protects the confidentiality of probation records from public disclosure except by order of the court.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the National Center for Juvenile Justice be granted access to data from the 18th Judicial Circuit Court's Probation and Court Services Department to provide juvenile justice professionals, policymakers, researchers and the public with the most detailed information available on the Nations' juvenile courts.
