WHEREAS, Ms. Jenna Goebel is conducting research on identifying the impact of racial bias when assessing juvenile offenders as the basis of her Doctoral Clinical Research Project at Roosevelt University; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Jenna Goebel has requested to conduct research on completed Court Ordered juvenile psychological evaluations using the Millon Adolescent Clinical Inventory (MACI) from the 18th Judicial Circuit's Department of Probation and Court Services and further to share the findings of her Clinical Research Project with the Department; and

WHEREAS, the Forensic Psychologist, Dr. John Murray conducts psychological evaluations of juvenile offenders using the Millon Adolescent Clinical Inventory (MACI), and


WHEREAS, the information that will be given to the student researcher will not be accessible to anyone outside of the project in a manner that any individual could be identified; and

WHEREAS, 730 ILCS 110/12 (4) protects the confidentiality of probation records from public disclosure except by order of the Court; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that John Murray, Psy. D. of the Department of Probation and Court Services is granted leave to make available for inspection all existing juvenile psychological evaluations using the Millon Adolescent Clinical Inventory (MACI) to Ms. Jenna Goebel to contribute to her research project. Publication or dissemination of the results of this research shall in no way disclose the identity of any individual interviewed by Dr. Murray, or violate the confidentiality of any court records. This order shall remain in effect until October 1, 2016.
