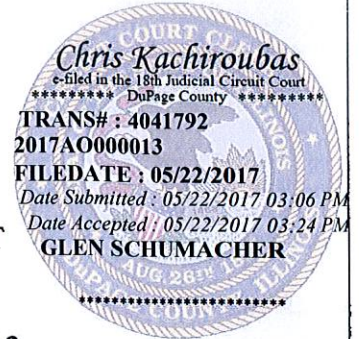

WHEREAS, select members of the 18th Judicial Circuit's Department of Probation and Court Services are additionally members of the DuPage County Juvenile Justice Council, which is tasked with conducting an interagency assessment of the local juvenile justice system and developing a juvenile justice plan for the prevention of juvenile delinquency per the Juvenile Court Act of 1987 (705 ILCS 405/6-12(2)(a)); and

WHEREAS, members of the DuPage County Juvenile Justice Council are to develop a local assessment and plan by utilizing aggregate data to analyze the risks, needs, and characteristics of youth in contact with the juvenile justice system per the Juvenile Court Act of 1987 (705 ILCS 405/6-12(2)(b)); and

WHEREAS, the Department of Probation and Court Services of the 18th Judicial Circuit possesses said data which will be crucial for analysis and development of a plan to address areas of need in DuPage County to decrease delinquency and increase community safety; and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Court Act of 1987 (705 ILCS 405/6-12(2)(b) encourages local offices to collaborate with juvenile justice councils to develop intergovernmental agreements and to share data and information in order to provide an adequate basis for the local juvenile justice plan; and


WHEREAS, all data will be collected without personally identifying information; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Probation and Probation Officers Act (730 ILCS 110/12(4) protects the confidentiality of probation records from public disclosure except by order of the court.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Dr. Brandon Kooi be granted access to data from the 18th Judicial Circuit Court's Probation and Court Services Department to provide the DuPage County Juvenile Justice Council with the most detailed information available on local trends and needs analysis of the DuPage County Juvenile Justice System.
