
WHEREAS, the Circuit Judges of the 18th Judicial Circuit adopted local Circuit Court Rules on November 16, 2004; and

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2018, **Circuit Court Rules 2.02 (b) Filing of Documents, and 6.04(d) Motions Generally** were amended.

18th JUDICIAL CIRCUIT RULE CHANGES

Adopted February 14, 2018

Rule 2.02 (b) FILING OF DOCUMENTS

b) Any document to be filed in a civil cause or proceeding must be filed electronically through an approved electronic filing vendor. Paper filings may be accepted **under exceptional circumstance, but will be converted to an electronic form pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Rule 9(c).**

Rule 6.04(d) MOTIONS GENERALLY

(d) Notice of Hearing: Except for emergency motions or notice by personal service as defined by Supreme Court Rule 11(c)(1), hearing on a motion shall proceed not less than five (5) court days after the effective date of service as defined by Supreme Court Rule 12(c). If notice of motion is by personal service delivered by 4:00 p.m., hearing on the motion shall proceed not less than the second court day following personal service.
