**WHEREAS**, the County of DuPage has entered into an intergovernmental agreement with the County of Kane designating the Kane County Juvenile Justice Center as the place for reception of minors who are not released pursuant to 705 ILCS 405/5-7 of the Juvenile Court Act; and

**WHEREAS**, due to a labor strike by Kane County probation and detention officers, the Kane County Juvenile Justice Center was temporarily unable to accept minors into their facility and the minors were thus transported to the Will County Juvenile Detention Center beginning April 30, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kane County Juvenile Justice Center is again capable of accepting minors detained pursuant to the intergovernmental agreement, orders or statutes; and


**WHEREAS**, the Court takes cognizance of both the need for the detention of appropriate minors, as well as the need for public safety.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the DuPage County Department of Probation and Court Services has the authority to determine which minors detained pursuant to court orders or statutes will be transported from the Will County Juvenile Detention Center to the Kane County Juvenile Justice Center for the period of June 28, 2018 through and including July 6, 2018.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this administrative order shall remain in effect until further order of this court.
