

## **“Hall of Justice” Art Competition**

The Arts Commission for the 18<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit Court invites DuPage County high school students to submit artwork for an art competition to be displayed in the “Hall of Justice” on the first floor of the Henry J. Hyde Judicial Office Facility (“courthouse”), 505 N. County Farm Road, Wheaton, Illinois. All art submissions must be dropped off from January 6- January 10, 2019, 2:30 – 4:30 p.m. at Jury Commission on the first floor of the courthouse. The deadline for art submissions is by 4:30 p.m. on January 10, 2020.

### **Art Competition Guidelines:**

- 1) All original artwork submitted must represent a theme of American legal justice. For inspiration, students can reference documents like the Declaration of Independence, U.S. Constitution, Bill of Rights, Gettysburg Address, etc. and review items such as Lady Justice, Scales of Justice, general legal books etc.
- 2) Artists may only submit 2D Artwork with no greater dimensions than 20” x 24” and it must be wired to hang (NO 3D artwork may be submitted).
- 3) Paintings, prints, drawings and mixed mediums are acceptable artwork.
- 4) A label must be affixed to the back of the artwork with the artist’s name, school, email address and phone number.
- 5) Students must complete and include a Student information and release form.
- 6) Each entry must be original in concept, design, and execution and may not violate U.S. copyright laws.
- 7) Artwork must be appropriate for display in the public area of the Courthouse. While it is not the intent to censor any artwork, the Chief Judge retains the right to refuse submissions that are not appropriate for display in the courthouse.
- 8) All artwork submitted will be on display from January 13, 2020 through January 17, 2020.

### **Awards:**

- 1) The Arts Commission will choose artwork that will remain on display in the Hall of Justice of the courthouse for one year. The artist’s name, school and year will appear underneath the artwork.
- 2) Unveiling and Presentation of Awards: Chief Justice Dan Guerin will unveil the winners and their artwork at a presentation to be held on January 25, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. in the Chief Judge’s Conference Room.
- 3) All artists will receive a certificate. Additionally, winners will receive ribbons and a monetary award.
