PURSUANT TO 725-ILCS 5/115-17B)

WHEREAS, in a criminal investigation of an offense involving the sexual exploitation of children, the Attorney General or State’s Attorney may issue and serve subpoena duces tecum to providers of electronic communication services or remote computing services requiring the production of relevant records, pursuant to 725 ILCS 5/115-17b(a) and (b); and


WHEREAS, any subpoena duces tecum issued pursuant to the above-reference statute shall be returnable to the Chief Judge of the Circuit Court for the Circuit in which the State’s Attorney resides, or **his or her designee**, (emphasis added); and

WHEREAS, for any subpoena issued by the Attorney General, the subpoena shall be made returnable to the Chief Judge of the Circuit Court for the Circuit in which the investigation pertains, or **his or her designee** (emphasis added); and

WHEREAS, due to the nature of the offenses delineated in 725 ILCS 5/115-17b(a) which are subject to criminal investigation, the Chief Judge names as his designee for the purpose outlined in the above-reference statute, the Presiding Judge of the Felony Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that any administrative subpoenas issued pursuant to 725-ILCS 5/115-17b shall be returnable to the Presiding Judge of the Felony Division for any further action pursuant to the statute.
