**WHEREAS**, the outbreak of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in the United States has necessitated the justice system to take prudent, proactive measures to reduce the risk of exposure and prevent the spread of the virus; and,

**WHEREAS**, due to the frequently changing circumstances involved with the COVID-19 pandemic, measures must continue to be implemented and updated to both protect the health and safety of all those working inside the courthouse and the public, and to ensure the fair and efficient access to justice; and,

**WHEREAS**, persons who have completed the DuPage County Bar Association Driver Improvement School as a requirement of their traffic court sentences have been unable to have their sentences satisfactorily terminated due to the closing of the four DuPage County Traffic Courts because of the outbreak of COVID-19; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is not in the best interests of justice or the public to require those who have complied with the sentencing requirement of completion of the Driver Improvement School by their ordered final termination date and have no other alleged violations of their sentence to personally return to court at a rescheduled date because of COVID-19,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that with the agreement of the prosecutors in the pending cases where the DuPage County Bar Association Driver Improvement School has been completed as a condition of the sentence: any petition to revoke the sentence alleging a failure to complete the Driver Improvement School is withdrawn; the case satisfactorily terminated; all future court dates stricken; and the Clerk of the Circuit Court to notify the Secretary of State of the failure to pay any outstanding balance of fines and assessments or court costs.
